

## Where we are

The Vagabond Lodge is 1 km. north of Mkwaja in the district of Pangani, Tanga region. Approximately 2 km from the borders of Saadani National Park and 12 from its entrance gate.

Distances: Zanzibar island 40 km east, to the north Pangani and Tanga 50 and 100 km respectively, south Bagamoyo is 105 km away and Dar es Salaam about 170 km.

In the Park there are 2 runways: one is near the Saadani village and the other is nearby, at Mkwaja. Both are a 15 minute flight from Zanzibar. There is another runway near Pangani. If you are driving from Dar es Salaam it takes about three and a half hours, half of which is through the Saadani park making it a very pleasant ride.



## Why should you choose to holiday at The Vagabond Lodge?

First of all to combine a beach holiday with a safari. From "The Vagabond Lodge" your safari starts in the morning as soon as you leave the gates. You can come back to lunch in a comfortable atmosphere overlooking the beach. After a relaxing siesta on the beach you can go back to see more animals. It's the perfect place for nature lovers. Compared to more famous locations here in Mkwaja you can still breathe the real African atmosphere of times gone by.

The uncontaminated nature isn't just inside the Saadani reserve: nature abounds all around the Vagabond lodge and the proximity of the national park guarantees the presence of all sorts of wildlife. Even elephants have often come near the lodge.

The beach in front of the resort is endless and not crowded. At low tide walking near the coral reef you can see all types of marine life: fish, sponges, seashells, anemones, sand stars, crabs and even lobsters.

## Le Camere



Rooms are available in 3 different solutions and prices:

The **Suite rooms** are directly on the beach, more spacious (47 square meters including veranda) with comfortable furnishings, bed, sitting area and bathroom.

All have: AC, Fan, Minibar, Safe, TV  
**Standard rooms** (32 sqm. including veranda), slightly backward compared to the suites, about 100 meters from the sea, and have traditional furnishings, bathroom and fan.



Are also available the cheapest **Camping rooms** equal to the standard rooms but without bathroom, therefore benefit from of the nearby facility center of the camping area.

## Campsite

The tourist complex also includes an equipped area for camping. Is available to our campers guests, a modern and well equipped services center, also the free use of traditional cuisine, barbecue and large restaurant with traditional makuti roof.

## Safari

**The Saadani National Park**, it's the only wildlife sanctuary of eastern Africa along the shore. The warm and humid climate, typical along the coast, has contributed to create a unique variety of flora and wildlife on land and sea. There are about 30 different species of mammals and an infinite variety of reptiles and birds.



The **Wami river** flows through the Park, the mangroves the birds and the noises coming from the forest make a trip on the river a remarkable experience, you can often see hippos and crocodiles.

The Park also includes a **Sandy Atoll**. At low tide

you can admire a sandbank surrounded by a **coral reef**. The variety of marine life is extraordinary. Diving, snorkeling or just walking near the reef is amazing. You can see over 40 species of fish, sand stars of every shape and colour, octopus, lobster, anemones and corals, alyccionaires, turtles, dolphins and even whales. Here turtles come to lay their eggs.
